



Breaking Bread

'House Arrest' Lessons from Paul

Neil Pattison





1. God works in our imprisonment

What we see as restriction or prison can be the very thing God is using to work in us and through us.

Is your house a prison or a fortress and place or safety?

As we were staying there for some days, a prophet named Agabus came down from Judea. And coming to us, he took Paul's belt and bound his own feet and hands, and said, "This is what the Holy Spirit says: 'In this way the Jews at Jerusalem will bind the man who owns this belt and deliver him into the hands of the Gentiles.'" When we had heard this, we as well as the local residents began begging him not to go up to Jerusalem. Then Paul answered, "What are you doing, weeping and breaking my heart? For I am ready not only to be bound, but even to die at Jerusalem for the name of the Lord Jesus." And since he would not be persuaded, we fell silent, remarking, "The will of the Lord be done!" **Acts 21:10-14**



2. Embrace what God is doing

There are times to embrace what God is doing. Do not fight against it but seek the Lord and understand the times and opportunities.

Much of the soil in the forest is a reservoir of untapped potential, a world of uncertain possibilities. In addition to the accumulated water and mineral nutrients, there is a bank of dormant seeds, each concealed at various depths in the ground, apparently inactive, in a state of limbo between life and death. But one dayperhaps there has been a storm- a great tree falls and the soil is disturbed. Certain seeds are churned up to the surface after untold years, and light floods down to activate them. **Stephen Thompson**



2. Embrace what God is doing

At the end of three months we set sail on an Alexandrian ship which had wintered at the island, and which had the Twin Brothers for its figurehead. After we put in at Syracuse, we stayed there for three days. From there we sailed around and arrived at Rhegium, and a day later a south wind sprang up, and on the second day we came to Puteoli. There we found some brethren, and were invited to stay with them for seven days; and thus we came to Rome. And the brethren, when they heard about us, came from there as far as the Market of Appius and Three Inns to meet us; and when Paul saw them, he thanked God and took courage. When we entered Rome, Paul was allowed to stay by himself, with the soldier who was guarding him. Acts 28:11-16 (NASB)



3. Paul's captivity was God's opportunity

Paul's captivity was God's opportunity to bless others.

And he stayed two full years in his own rented quarters and was welcoming all who came to him, preaching the kingdom of God and teaching concerning the Lord Jesus Christ with all openness, unhindered. **Acts 28:30-31**



God is getting the attention of the whole world.

We must not leave this period unchanged.

It is time to bear fruit.
